WHEREAS, Lennar Homes, LLC (the "Petitioner") petitioned the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "Orlando City Council"), to enact an ordinance establishing the Storey Drive Community Development District (the "District") pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, over the real property described in Exhibit 2 of the Petition to Establish the Storey Drive Community Development District; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner currently owns all of the property located within the boundaries of the proposed District and has provided written consent to the establishment of the District as the entity owning 100 percent of the real property to be included in the District; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner is a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Florida, Petitioner's principal place of business is 2300 Maitland Center Parkway, Suite 320, Maitland, Florida 32751; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been conducted by the Orlando City Council on March 15, 2021, in accordance with the requirements and procedures of section 190.005(2)(b), Florida Statutes, and the applicable requirements and procedures of the City's Charter and Code of Ordinances; all interested persons and affected units of general-purpose local government were afforded an opportunity to present oral and written comments on the Petition at said duly noticed public hearing; and

WHEREAS, upon consideration of the record established at that hearing, the Orlando City Council determined that the statements within the Petition were true and correct, that the establishment of the District is not inconsistent with any applicable element or portion of the state comprehensive plan or the City's comprehensive plan, that the land within the District is of sufficient size, is sufficiently compact, and sufficiently contiguous to be developable as a functionally interrelated community, that the District is the best alternative available for delivering community development services and facilities to the area served by the District, that the community development services and facilities of the District will not be incompatible with the capacity and uses of existing
